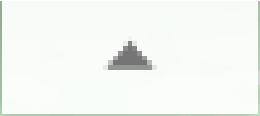

From 140 Faith Assembly Church Rd London, KY
Turn right onto KY-80 Hal Rogers Pkwy (5.1 mi)
Turn right onto White Oak Rd (174 ft)
Turn left at the 1st cross street onto KY-1956 W (2.4 mi)
6880 Somerset Rd London, KY 40741

Description

A heavily trafficked out and back trail located near London, Kentucky features beautiful wild flowers and offers a number of activity options and is accessible year-round. Dogs are also able to use this trail but must be kept on leash. The trail turns south and follows dry sandy ridges along old county roads. The trail crosses private land in this area. The trail intersects Forest Service Road 4098 and 4095 before dropping into the Hawk Creek drainage. The creek is stocked with rainbow trout. A 100-foot suspension bridge crosses over Hawk Creek along the trail. Several waterfalls and overlooks occur in the area. The trail eventually winds its way up to KY 1956. Trail users must respect the rights of private landowners and stay on the trail. Unlicensed motorized vehicles are not allowed on public roads. Hiking and mountain biking only are allowed on this section of trail.
